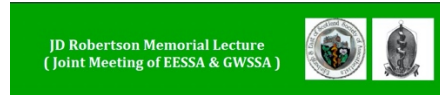

Theme of this year's lecture :

"Landscape Architecture professor Iain Robertson will describe the trials, tribulations and triumphs experienced by students in a 'Cultivating Creativity' class he teaches for undergraduates in programs across the University of Washington. This unusual class uses diverse and unusual exercises and techniques to encourage UW Honors Students to develop their innate creative abilities. The attitudes of mind that the class 'cultivates' are ones that seem to have fallen through the cracks in high pressure academic curricula but are vital for success in all walks of life. They include the ability to improvise and work effectively in ambiguous situations; fluid thought patterns that enable us to make provocative and useful connections; and close observation of the world that allows us to derive inspiration from the forms, material qualities and cultural variety of every-day things."

The talk will be illustrated with examples of student's work, students at work, and a medley of images of Seattle, the source of the Amazon, the sacred grounds of Starbucks, Microsoft and Boeing.

The lecture is followed by dinner
